

BODY CLINICAL CASES WITH BIO STIMULATION PLUS: TCA-H2O2 COMBINED

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Objectives

The aim of these clinical cases is to evaluate the efficacy of TCA-H2O2 Combined to improve the quality and firmness of the skin of abdomen, buttocks and thighs.

Material - methods

Three clinical cases treated with TCA-H2O2 combined in three different areas: abdomen, buttocks and thighs.

All of them – with no relevant histories – report a lack of hydration and firmness in the area.

The treatment:

TCA-H2O2 for corporal use is an internationally patented Medical Device containing Trichloroacetic acid (TCA), a well-known peeling agent. Despite of this, TCA-H2O2 disclosed new features, completely different effects and indications, becoming an innovative non-injective biorevitalizer, that is able to give the dermis an effective stimulation without damaging the epidermis and avoiding the subsequent exfoliation.

It is about a non-invasive, very flexible device, useful for stand-alone treatments or combined protocols with other common and popular procedures in aesthetics medicine.

TCA-H2O2 constitutes an original means, without significant side effects, suitable at any time of the year, very appreciated by patients, that may complement other corporal techniques and be associated with most procedures in aesthetics medicine, and amplify their results in relation to improve the quality and firmness of the skin of abdomen, buttocks and thighs.

TCA-H2O2 acts very well as a unique treatment, but the synergistic effect of some associated treatments may offer results superior to the sum of the treatments separately, and often the result is greater than 2.
